Dear Mr. Najjar:

I write in response to yours of this date. I am puzzled by your assertion that the auditors have refused to “provide advance information” about the subject matter of their requested interview with Mr. Smith and Gafcon. The subject matter of the interviews requested has not been unclear so far as I know. The auditors have simply determined that submitting questions in writing rather than interview principals in person is too time consuming, expensive and ineffective to meet the task they were hired for. The request for an interview certainly would not preclude Mr. Smith from accessing or reviewing his files in advance; nor would it preclude him from talking with other personnel should he need to do so in order to answer any question or provide additional information.


The auditors believe that the City has a right to expect your cooperation with the performance review in the manner which the auditors believe to be appropriate. They believe an in person interview will be much less time consuming for all parties. Moreover, based on their review of the Schematic Design Contract Compliance Review report issued June 15, 2012, it is not accurate to say that you fully cooperated with the
