Dear Judge Wieben Stock:

As you are aware, Gafcon has been a target in the ongoing Great Park Audit by the City of Irvine. While we support the audit process and have cooperated with all appropriate requests from the City of Irvine, the false accusations made by the City have forced us to speak up and question the legitimacy of this audit. In the months following the release of the preliminary audit report in January 2014, we compiled compelling and substantial evidence that disproves every allegation against our company, and we would appreciate the opportunity to share this evidence with you.

On February 23, 2015, we wrote to the City of Irvine asking for a meeting with you. Unfortunately, the City has not responded to our request. As the mediator of this issue, we believe it is important for you to understand the evidence supporting our claims that this has been a bias and flawed audit process. We believe that this evidence will be helpful to you in your role as mediator of this issue. We feel that the documents and statements we have compiled provide clear evidence for a complete exoneration of our name and our work on this project.

Thank you for participation in this process and taking the time to ensure the final audit follows professional standards and upholds the integrity of the audit process, and that any final report will rectify the errors and false accusations of the earlier report.
